Part 1: Getting Started


Start with the toolbar

The Toolbar

When you open the Word of Promise PC Edition for the first time, the navigation toolbar appears with the book of John as the default. (As shown in the example to the right)

Contents Menu

When clicking the contents menu tab at the top left-hand corner of your screen, the books of the Bible menu will appear. (As seen in the image on the left)

Make it Yours

Bookmarks: Bookmarks the current verse selected



Notes: Create notes for the current verse selected



Share via email: Share selected verse/s via email




Facebook: Share verse/s by logging into your account

Printing

Select the verse/s or chapter you want to print, then click on the printer icon in the upper right-hand corner of your screen. This will allow you to print the NKJV text with your own personal notes.

Part 3: Hearing and Searching

Playing audio and searching text

Word of Promise Audio

Listening to the Word of Promise dramatized audio has never been easier. Simply select verse/s or a chapter, then click on the play icon. As the audio plays, the text will be underlined in sync with the audio.



Searching

To search the Bible, simply enter a phrase or word into the search field at the bottom left of your screen. You will get an instant result from across the NKJV Bible.

Part 4: Viewing and Customizing

View Options and Customizing

View Options

The Word of Promise PC Edition gives you the option to choose how you view the Bible. Select from one of the viewing options. These tools are located in the lower right-hand corner of your screen.



Page View

Displays text one page at a time



Two Page View

Displays two pages at a time, similar to an open book



Scroll View

Displays in continuous scrolling mode



Customizing

Customize your reading experience by clicking the settings tab at the top right of your screen. For Example, to change the color behind the text, uncheck “Use Paper Background”. To the right you can then select your color preference.

Footnotes



Reading Footnotes

When putting your cursor over the diamond or asterisk symbol, you will be shown the footnotes for that verse, as seen in Figure 1. When you click on a verse, you will be taken to a floating window. From here you can read and play the audio from the specified verse, as seen in Figure 2.


